Booth setups are available for sponsors free for the \$1000 level and up; otherwise the fee is \$100. Sponsorship is tax-deductible.

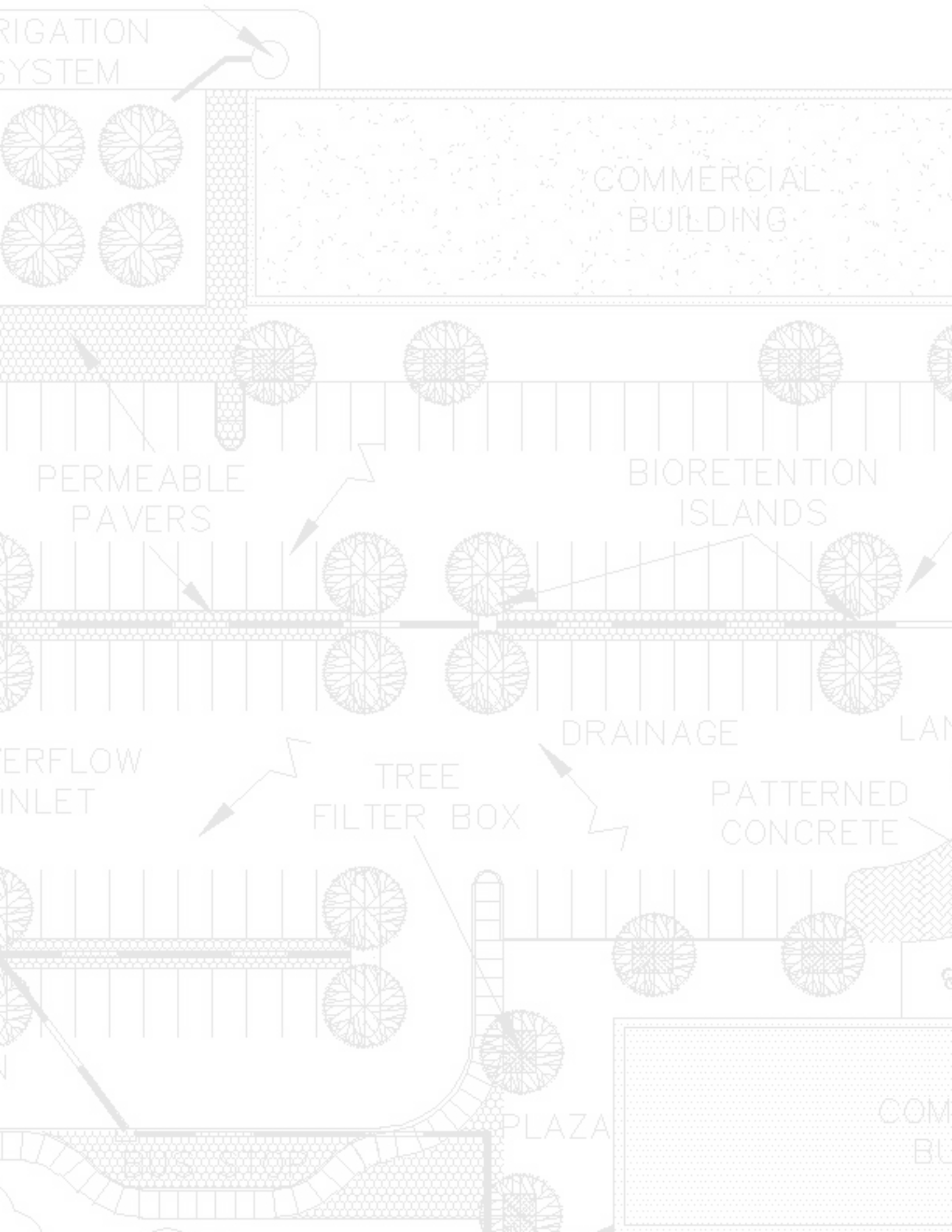
